DAY 5 - COLOGNE, BONN 🗇 🕗 **& KOBLENZ**

INCLUDED: Even people who aren't into cathedrals are awed by Cologne Cathedral, a hulking Gothic structure that looms over the city. Your U Host will share stories of the site's colorful history and show you the shrine containing relics of the Three Magi.

U TIME - GERMAN HISTORY: Despite its rather stiff-sounding name, the German National Museum of Contemporary History in Bonn is home to an extraordinary collection spanning German history from the Cold War to the present day.

U TIME - CASTLE DINING: Go medieval tonight at a grand banquet at a bona fide castle, featuring rustic food, Rhine wines, lute-strumming bards and saucy serving wenches.

INCLUDED: Your guided evening stroll in Koblenz starts at the locals' favorite gathering place, the German Corner, where the Rhine and the Moselle rivers meet.

DAY 6 - RÜDESHEIM & FRANKFURT

INCLUDED: You'll want to be up on deck as we cruise through the fabled Rhine Gorge, lined with fairytale castles and ruined fortresses. Later, you can head ashore in Rüdesheim for a scenic hike that offers amazing views of the surrounding countryside.

UTIME - ABBEY WINE: "Game of Thrones" fans will love Eberbach Monastery—its ethereal 12th-century architecture made it an ideal film location for the show. There are no dragons here today, but you can taste the abbey's Rieslings and enjoy a scenic bike ride, too.

NIGHT OUT: Cosmopolitan Frankfurt is a city of contrasts, home to bankers and hipsters, avant-garde skyscrapers and ancient abodes. After dark, delve into its vibrant nightlife scene, visiting bars, clubs and under-the-radar hot spots with your U Host.

DAY 7 - FRANKFURT

INCLUDED: In the "Mainhattan" of Germany—Europe's largest financial center—you can explore the Old Town on foot or on two wheels, stopping at the Kleinmarkthalle to do some shopping for tonight's cooking class or visiting the city's Sunday flea market.

We at U by Uniworld want to do everything we can to make sure your trip is enjoyable and worry-free. As part of that commitment, we are including the following information about your trip. Please read these pages carefully, as payment of a deposit represents an acceptance of the U by Uniworld Terms and Conditions.

YOUR TRIP

Prices: All fares are per guest in U.S. Dollars based on double occupancy unless otherwise noted. Fares are capacity controlled and are subject to change at any time without notice. Fares for single guests are available upon request. If you have purchased your transatlantic or transpacific air with U by Uniworld and/or you have purchased a cruise package with U by Uniworld that includes air, your entire package price will be guaranteed at time of initial payment. Additional restrictions may apply.

Reservations and Payments: A deposit of at least 10% of the cruise fare per person is required within 72 hours of reservation. Cruise fare is defined as the cruise, plus port charges less all applied discounts at time of booking. Final payment is due at least 120 days prior to departure. Reservations will be canceled if final payment is not received in a timely manner. For all guests booking air travel with U by Uniworld, a separate non-refundable airfare deposit of \$450 per person is required at time of booking. Upon receipt of air deposit your airfare, tax and fuel surcharges are final. You may cancel your air within 24 hours of booking and receive a full refund of the airfare deposit.

Items Not Included in the Published Price: These include, but are not limited to, airfares to and from your destination; airport/departure taxes; port charges; excess baggage charges; aircraft seat assignments; Arrival and departure transfers, meals not detailed in the itinerary, cost of passports and visas; taxes; laundry; phone calls; all items of a personal nature; items not included on regular menus; beverages (except for water, tea and coffee - available at the self-serve coffee station); expenses for additional sightseeing not specified in the itinerary; and health, accident, baggage, or travel protection plans.

Cruise Cancellation Policy: We hope nothing will come between you and your U by Uniworld vacation. Should you need to cancel your booking or any portion of it, your cancellation must be received in writing. It will be effective on the date of receipt. Cancellation charges, per person and based upon the date of cancellation, are as follows:

These cancellation fees are in addition to any cancellation fees that might be levied by your travel agent. There is no refund for unused services or for unused portions of the trip. For true worry-free travel, please see the Travel Protection Plan section of this brochure or visit uniworld.com. The Travel Protection Plan premium is non-refundable once paid to U by Uniworld.

Revision Fee: A fee of \$35 per person, per transaction, will be charged for any passenger name change, cruise date change (within the same calendar year only) or itinerary change made to a reservation after the booking is confirmed unless the change increases the value of the booking. A passenger name change, cruise date change or itinerary change within one hundred and twenty (120) days of departure will be treated as a cancellation subject to our cancellation policy, and a new reservation must be made. Cancellation fees (as shown above) will apply. Any revision to a booking may result in the loss of a confirmed airline reservation, change fees (refer to the Air Travel change fees section for details) and increased airfare in addition to any charges levied by the airlines, which will be payable by the Passenger.

YOUR FLIGHT

Airfare: U by Uniworld wants to help make your entire vacation smooth sailing, so we offer great values on airfares from most major cities in the U.S. Please contact your Travel Professional or U by Uniworld for the most up-to-date prices. As airfares and schedules are subject to availability, we encourage you to book early. Business Class flights may not be available for flights within the U.S. or Europe and may require travel in economy class. A separate non-refundable air deposit of \$450 per person is due for the airfare booked in conjunction with a U by Uniworld cruise and is required at the time air is booked. Upon receipt of air deposit your airfare, tax and fuel surcharges are final. You may cancel your air within 24 hours of booking and receive a full refund of the cost of the airfare. We may issue your air ticket at any time after you book and pay for your non-refundable air deposit.

Air Travel Change Fees: If you, as the Passenger, change your air travel itinerary before your ticket is issued, you will be charged a \$35 per person change fee (see Revision Fee). This charge will apply each time you make a change. If you change your air travel plans after your ticket is issued, you will be charged a \$75 per person per change fee, and you will be responsible for any increase in airfare and/or penalties levied by the airline, which may be up to 100% of the air ticket value.

Airline Cancellations: You may cancel your air within 24 hours of booking and receive a full refund of the cost of the airfare. If you, as the passenger, choose to cancel your air 120 days or more prior to the departure date, your \$450 air deposit is non-refundable. If air is canceled 119 days or less, penalties of at least \$450 up to 100% of the air price will apply.

Air Bookings and Restrictions: TSA regulations require us to collect the full first, middle and last name as it appears on your passport or government-issued ID, as well as date of birth and gender. This information is required before we can book your air. U by Uniworld is not responsible for denied boarding or reissue costs due to an incorrect name, date of birth, or gender information supplied to U by Uniworld. Flight it interaries provided prior to ticketing are subject to change without notice. U by Uniworld is not responsible for any inconvenience or any costs or fees incurred by delays, lost luggage, or disruption of air service. Flight it interaries provided are subject to change by the Air Carrier(s). We recommend you contact the airline within seven (7) days of departure to reconfirm your flights.

Custom Air Service: To give you even more options and greater flexibility, U by Uniworld offers customized air reservations. This service is available for \$95 per person, plus any applicable increased air costs. The service fee is non-refundable upon confirmation of the request.

Seat Assignments and Special Services: Requests for seat assignments, special meals and special services must be made directly to the airline. Not all airlines offer pre-assigned seats, some may charge for pre-assigned seats and any additional charge imposed by the airlines will be at the guest's expense. Seating is solely under the airline's control, as are itinerary changes, flight delays and schedule changes. Some airfares used by U by Uniworld are not eligible for frequent flyer mileage.

Transfers include: Amsterdam Airport to Amsterdam Ship and vice versa, Budapest Airport to Budapest Ship and vice versa, Prankfurt Airport to Frankfurt Ship and vice versa, Paris, Charles de Gaulle Airport to Paris Ship and vice versa and Munich Airport to Regensburg Ship and vice versa.

Baggage Fees, Baggage and Personal Belongings: U by Uniworld allows one (1) suitcase, one (1) carry-on bag, and one (1) personal bag (handbag, computer case, etc.) per person onboard our ships and motorcoaches. Airlines may have additional baggage restrictions and may impose additional fees for checked baggage and/or excess baggage (visit iflybags.com). Additional taxes and surcharges may be collected by foreign government and non-government entities. Keep an eye on your baggage—it is your responsibility throughout the trip. U by Uniworld is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to baggage and/or personal belongings at any time during the cruise, or on included transfers and other transportation. A protection plan covering lost, stolen or damaged baggage is available through the U by Uniworld Travel Protection Plan.

U-Documents: U-documents will be ready to download within sixty (60) days prior to embarkation. Your booking must be paid in full and your passenger information completed before U-documents will be available to download.

Passport/Visa: A valid passport is required to travel on all U by Uniworld programs. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the scheduled return date of the trip. You should check with your travel agent or the U.S. Consulate Service for information regarding necessary visas and other documentation. Non-U.S. citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry requirements pertaining to your trip.

Any visa(s) or other documentation required for a particular itinerary is the sole responsibility of the guest. U by Uniworld will not be responsible for advising and/or obtaining required travel documentation for any passenger, or for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip, related to improper travel documentation.

Due to government-imposed security/immigration measures, passport information and emergency contact information are required for all passengers prior to release of documentation.

Itineraries are subject to change without notice and may need to be altered specifically because of water levels, wind factors, or other conditions. Guests who choose to cancel or interrupt their cruise due to an itinerary change will be subject to our standard Cancellation Policy.

Advanced, Canceled, or Delayed Sailing: U by Uniworld reserves the right to cancel, advance or postpone any scheduled sailing date and may, but is not obligated to, substitute vessels.
